ADMINISTRATIVE DISCRETION REGARDING BOARD POLICY

PURPOSE: To delineate the Superintendent's authority to take immediate actions consistent with law and Board policies.

The Board recognizes that, in the course of operating District schools or implementing District programs, situations may arise which may not be addressed in written policies. In such situations, or when immediate action is necessary to avoid any risk to the safety or security of students, staff, or District property, or to prevent disruption of school operations, the Superintendent is delegated the authority to take necessary action in circumstances not provided for in board policies, provided that such action is consistent with law and board policies and is reported, as appropriate, to the Board at the meeting next following such action. This action shall be subject to review by the Board at which time it may duly consider the need for one or more policies to cover future situations of a similar nature.

As necessary, the Superintendent or designee shall consult with other District staff, including legal counsel and/or the chief business official, regarding the exercise of this authority.
