PERSONNEL Certificated, Classified, Administrative and Supervisory DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING FOR EMPLOYEES WITH COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES/SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS

PURPOSE: To develop a process for administering drug and alcohol testing for bus drivers and other employees who must hold and use a commercial driver's license during the course of employment in the District.

A. General Statement

The District shall adhere to all state and federal laws and regulations requiring drug and alcohol testing for employees who must hold and use a commercial driver's license during the course of employment.

B. Covered Positions

School bus drivers and other persons who drive vehicles which transport 16 or more passengers; vehicles which have a gross weight rating of 26,001 pounds; and vehicles which transport hazardous materials which require placard display are subject to this policy and applicable administrative regulations.

C. <u>Testing Program</u>

District policy, procedures, regulations, testing procedures, and facilities used for tests shall conform to all state and federal requirements, including, but not limited to Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Part 40, Title 49, Part 382, the California Vehicle Code, and California Code of Regulations, Title 13, Chapter 6.5.
