Admissions Residency and Attendance

EXEMPTIONS/EXCLUSION FROM COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE

PURPOSE: To specify circumstances where students may be statutorily exempt or excluded from school attendance.

The Board believes education is one of the most important functions of state and local governments. As such, the District will endeavor to provide an educational program designed to maximize educational opportunities for all students subject to compulsory attendance who reside within the District.

The Board is aware that specified circumstances statutorily exempt or exclude students from compulsory attendance in the public schools of California. Additionally, students may be exempted or excluded from school attendance when such attendance would be adverse to the physical or mental well-being of the student or the physical well-being of other students.

The Board directs the Superintendent to prepare an administrative regulation to set forth procedures which permit the exemption of a student from compulsory attendance when required by law or when necessary in the student's best interest and provide for the exclusion of a student whose attendance is adverse to the welfare of the child or other students.
