SPECIALIZED PHYSICAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES

PURPOSE: To define guidelines regarding specialized physical health care services for

students.

The Board is aware that some District students may require specialized physical health care services during the school day to be able to attend school. In accordance with the student's individualized education program (IEP) or written accommodation plan, trained and qualified personnel shall perform these services under the supervision of a credentialed school nurse, public health nurse, or licensed physician. The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to develop and adopt an administrative regulation setting forth procedures for providing such specialized physical health care services for students.
