TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

PURPOSE: To comply with applicable laws regarding tuberculosis testing of students.

The Board recognizes its responsibility to see that all students enrolled in District schools are tested for tuberculosis in accordance with applicable laws. The Board also recognizes that complying with tuberculosis testing requirements is a joint collaborative effort of parents, District employees, physicians, the public health department, and community resources.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent to develop and adopt an administrative regulation setting forth procedures to meet requirements for tuberculosis testing in accordance with applicable laws.
