## STUDENTS Adult and Community Education ADULT EDUCATION – STUDENT DISCIPLINE

PURPOSE: To establish a student discipline policy for Clovis Adult Education students.

The Board strives to provide a quality learning environment in all of its educational programs. To foster a safe learning environment, the Board has adopted this discipline policy for Clovis Adult Education students.

Students enrolled in the adult school program are required to satisfy the following expectations:

- 1. Attend assigned classes.
- 2. Arrive for class at the appointed time.
- 3. Do not eat or drink in the classroom.
- 4. Do not use, sell, possess, or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, including any controlled substance as defined in Health and Safety Code section 11007.
- 5. Demonstrate cooperation with and respect for teachers, administrators, personnel, and other students.
- 6. Do not smoke or use any other tobacco product while in District facilities or on school grounds.
- 7. Satisfy the expectations required by the educational provider.
- 8. Make a positive contribution to the adult school, its teachers, administrators, personnel, and other students.
- 9. Do not disrupt classes in any manner whatsoever.

The Board further directs the Superintendent or designee to develop and adopt an administrative regulation outlining behavior expectations, grounds for discipline, and procedures for discipline. The procedures are provided as a courtesy to the adult school and are not intended to create any expectations by the students or duties for District employees of Clovis Adult Education.

The principal of Clovis Adult Education or designee may suspend, expel, or remove from the adult school program a student for good cause.
