## Law Enforcement

**LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL ON CAMPUS/QUESTIONING AND  
APPREHENSION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**PURPOSE:** To address law enforcement officers' contact with pupils on school campuses and the appropriate manner for such contacts.

The Board believes that the safety of District students and staff is essential to achieving the goal of student learning. In accordance with standards specified in law, law enforcement officers may interview and question students on school premises and may remove them when appropriate.

The Superintendent or designee shall collaborate with local law enforcement agencies to establish procedures which enable law enforcement officers to carry out their duties on school campus, including, when necessary, the questioning and/or apprehension of students.

The Board appreciates that law enforcement and protective services personnel have a basic duty to protect the welfare of minors, particularly pertaining to physical and sexual abuse.

The Board directs the Superintendent to adopt an administrative regulation which will facilitate law enforcement in the performance of their duties in an orderly manner.

The Superintendent or designee is further directed to ensure that the administrative regulation provide for the protection of fundamental constitutional rights of pupils and provides for parent/guardian notification.
