CURRICULUM AND CURRICULUM INSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

PURPOSE: To establish policies and procedures for the development, implementation, and

evaluation of curriculum in the District.

A. Curriculum Instruction Management System

The Board recognizes its responsibility for the quality of the educational programs in the District's schools. To this end, the Board establishes this policy and directs the Superintendent or designee to maintain high quality curriculum and instruction in preschool through grade twelve with procedures for curricula to be developed, implemented, and evaluated accordingly.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to establish policies and procedures establishing a comprehensive Curriculum Instruction Management System to ensure the following:

- 1. District's curriculum shall be aligned with the District's vision and goals for student learning, as well as board policies, academic content standards, state and District assessments, graduation requirements, school improvement plans, and when necessary, related legal requirements.
- 2. A comprehensive process for curriculum development, implementation, evaluation, and modification shall be established which utilizes the professional expertise of teachers, principals, and District administrators representing various grade levels, disciplines, special programs, and categories of students as appropriate. The selection and evaluation of instructional materials shall be an integral part of the curriculum development process.
- 3. A review cycle for regularly evaluating the District's curriculum shall be established to ensure continued alignment with state and District goals for student achievement. At a minimum, these reviews shall be conducted whenever the State Board of Education adopts new or revised content standards or the curriculum framework for a particular subject or when new law requires a change or addition to the curriculum.
- 4. Annually, the Superintendent shall advise the Board of any program changes based on assessment data from the previous year.
- 5. Procedures and responsibilities shall be established to modify or eliminate any curriculum.

The selection, evaluation, and adoption of textbooks for use in the District shall be conducted in accordance with Board Policy and Administrative Regulation No. 6161.1 – Selection, Evaluation, and Adoption of Textbooks.
