INSTRUCTION Instructional Program HOMEWORK/MAKEUP WORK

PURPOSE: To establish the educational value of homework and makeup work.

The Board recognizes that meaningful homework assignments can be a valuable extension of student learning time and assist students in developing good study habits. Homework shall be assigned to support classroom lessons, enable students to complete unfinished assignments, or review and apply academic content for better understanding.

The Superintendent or designee shall collaborate with school administrators and teachers to develop and regularly review guidelines for the assignment of homework and the related responsibilities of students, staff, and parents/guardians.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to develop rules for the assignment of homework according to the guidelines set forth in the administrative regulation adopted by the Superintendent. The rules and guidelines should also outline the parameters for giving students the opportunity to complete assignments and tests missed while absent.

Suspended Students

When a parent/guardian of a student who has been suspended for two or more school days requests homework that the student would otherwise have been assigned, the student's teacher shall provide such homework. If a homework assignment is requested and is turned in to the teacher by the student either upon the student's return from suspension or within the timeframe originally prescribed by the teacher, whichever is later, and is not graded before the end of the academic term, the points associated with that homework assignment shall not be factored into the calculation of the student's overall grade in the class or otherwise counted against the student. (Education Code 48913.5)

The teacher of any class from which a student is suspended may require the student to complete any assignments and tests missed during the suspension. (Education Code 48913)
