INSTRUCTION Instructional Materials and Equipment SELECTION, EVALUATION, AND ADOPTION OF TEXTBOOKS

PURPOSE: To establish criteria and procedures for the selection, evaluation, and adoption of textbooks.

The Board recognizes its responsibility to provide quality textbooks for District students.

A. <u>Textbooks</u>

The Board shall adopt the primary text used in all courses/classes offered in the District.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent to adopt an administrative regulation to establish selection procedures for textbooks. The selection procedures shall provide for substantial involvement of teachers and shall encourage the participation of parents and community members. The procedures shall also evaluate whether the textbook accurately portrays individuals' roles and contributions in society and also enhances the use of multiple teaching strategies and technologies. (Education Code 60010, et seq.)

The Board authorizes the Superintendent or designee to take actions to implement this policy, including but not limited to:

- 1. Verifying content requirements of purchased textbooks that are not on the state approved list pursuant to the Education Code.
- 2. Establishing professional development for employees reflective of effective instructional strategies for implementation of newly adopted materials.
- 3. Establishing procedures for an annual textbook inventory and distribution control.

Individuals who participate in the selection or review or adoption of textbooks or other instructional materials shall not receive or accept any gift or inducements from a representative of any publisher, manufacturer or vendor.

The textbook adoption process will be coordinated by the Assistant Superintendent, Curriculum, Instruction and Accountability. All sample copies of textbooks shall be supplied to or requested through the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum, Instruction and Accountability.

B. <u>Instructional Materials</u>

Instructional materials for grades 9-12 that meet the criteria specified in law, this policy, and the administrative regulation shall be adopted by the Superintendent. (Education Code 60400)

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Standards-aligned materials in each core curriculum area shall be provided to each student at the beginning of the first school term.

C. Sufficiency of Textbooks

The availability of sufficient core curriculum standards-based textbooks for each student, including English learners, shall be assessed annually and reported to the Board in accordance with applicable law. Sufficiency shall be defined as adequate site inventories so that each student, including English learners, shall have appropriate standards aligned textbooks to use in class and take home for the core curriculum areas of English language arts, mathematics, science, and social science for preschool - 12. In addition, world language, health, and science laboratory equipment for grades 7 through 12, as appropriate shall be provided.
