CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION FOR REORGANIZING OR CLOSING A SCHOOL SITE

- 1. The projected general education enrollment is below the permanent design capacity as outlined in Exhibit No. 7110.2(1).
- 2. The projected general education enrollment for an elementary grade is below 50.
- 3. There is no opportunity for growth to occur within the existing boundary.
- 4. If the existing boundary is expanded, it will negatively impact neighboring school boundaries.
- 5. Home to school transportation is currently provided.
- 6. There is insufficient teaching staff to provide an effective co-curricular program.
- 7. There are not enough students to have a viable co-curricular program.
- 8. There are not enough students to provide an appropriate number of staffing units for the school.
- 9. The student enrollment is so low that other schools must provide staffing units to the small school.
- 10. There is community support from the school to reorganize or close the school.
- 11. There is a viable use for the facility if the school is reorganized.
- 12. There is a viable use for the facility if the school is closed.
