CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION FOR REORGANIZING OR CLOSING A SCHOOL SITE
1. The projected general education enrollment is below the permanent design capacity as outlined in Exhibit No. 7110.2(1).
2. The projected general education enrollment for an elementary grade is below 50.
3. There is no opportunity for growth to occur within the existing boundary.
4. If the existing boundary is expanded, it will negatively impact neighboring school boundaries.
5. Home to school transportation is currently provided.
6. There is insufficient teaching staff to provide an effective co-curricular program.
7. There are not enough students to have a viable co-curricular program.
8. There are not enough students to provide an appropriate number of staffing units for the school.
9. The student enrollment is so low that other schools must provide staffing units to the small school.
10. There is community support from the school to reorganize or close the school.
11. There is a viable use for the facility if the school is reorganized.
12. There is a viable use for the facility if the school is closed.
